Shed – Shelter Care Instructions & Warranty Information

Congratulations! We hope you enjoy your Cosy storage shed :). To get the most out your shed, there are a few things you need to do make sure your shed lasts as long as possible:

Safety Information

For safety please ensure that your shed/shelter is sited on solid, stable, flat, hard standing ground. We also recommend that you site it against a wall, building or fence and secure it in place to reduce any chance of severe weather tipping or damaging the shed/shelter.

Sheds and shelters are heavy items and must be moved and handled correctly when building and siting them. They should be moved by at least two people using best practice manual handling techniques and procedures.

To help avoid falls and damaging your shed/shelter please ensure children and adults do not climb on the shelves, clamber up the shed sides, stand on top of the shed/shelter, swing on the doors or use the shed/shelter in any way that puts themselves or others at risk of harm. Ensure its use is always well supervised.

Warranty & Care instructions

Our 2 year shed warranty covers against general timber rot and decay - It does not cover against timber splits or warping as these can occur naturally over time.

Please note: Sheds & shelters can be prone to changes in appearance and shape, especially in extreme weather conditions. These will not affect the structural integrity of the product, this is a natural feature and not covered in the warranty.

To ensure that your product warranty is valid, it is critical that you follow these procedures:

- Site the product on hard, level ground with good drainage such as tarmac, concrete or paving.
- If you are fixing your shed or shelter to a wall or fence; please make sure that any holes made are treated, that there is a gap left at the back for water to drain off the roof and that you don't pierce the felted areas.
- Heavy items should be stored on the bottom level of the shed/shelter to keep the centre of mass low in line with good health and safety approaches to the storage of resources and manual handling.
- Ensure that the shed/shelter is not positioned under or next to trees, bushes or foliage.
- Do not store wet items in the shed/shelter without appropriate ventilation or moisture control.
- The treatment on the shed/shelter MUST be re-applied every year. You can do this by purchasing a good non-toxic stain and applying it liberally to the outer panels of your shed.
- If the blackboard paint begins to deteriorate, you can refresh this by sanding off the spoiled paint and reapplying over this area. You can purchase this paint directly from Cosy or any respectable hardware retailer.
- For any self-assembly sheds, ensure that it is fully and correctly assembled by following the instructions that are provided with the item. Please contact Cosy if you do not receive these

- instructions prior to assembly as Cosy is not liable for damage caused by incorrect assembly. Small parts such as screws, rivets, nuts, bolts and washers need regular checks to ensure they are securely in place as part of your care and maintenance routines.
- If your shed/shelter has doors, ensure that at the end of each session, the doors are completely closed with all latches used where applicable to help lessen any warping over time.
- During periods of high wind, each setting should consider whether a shed/shelter needs additional securing and also whether an outdoor space is safe for children to play outside. We recommend securing your shed to the ground using ground bolts which are available from Cosy (product code 32754). Alternatively please visit: bit.ly/anchors for more information on how to secure your shed.
- If the risk of fire is raising a concern we would recommend using fire retardant paint or varnish on your shed.

****NOTE:** Please be sure that any stains or paints used are child-friendly and non-toxic.
